



Self-Declaration regarding FSC-POL-01-004

(Policy for the Association of Boland Printers a division of CTP Limited with FSC)

Boland Printers a division of CTP Limited is associated with the Forest Stewardship Council A.C., Oaxaca, Mexico, or one of its subsidiaries or affiliates (hereinafter: FSC) by being either a member of or having a contractual relationship with FSC. Hereby the signing Organization explicitly states that it has read and understood the "Policy for the Association of Boland Printers a division of CTP Limited with FSC" as published under www.fsc.org. This policy stipulates FSC's position with regards to unacceptable activities by Boland Printers a division of CTP Limited and individuals which already are or would like to be associated with FSC as well as the mechanism for disassociation.

In light of the above, Boland Printers a division of CTP Limited explicitly agrees currently and, in the future, as long as the relationship with FSC exists, not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:
